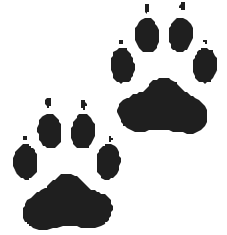

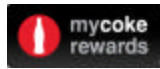


### Employment Opportunity
