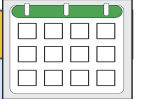

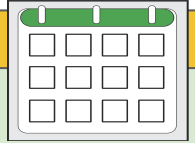

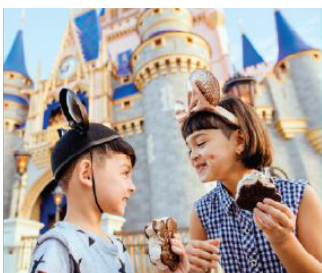

"Somebody Jesus Loves!"



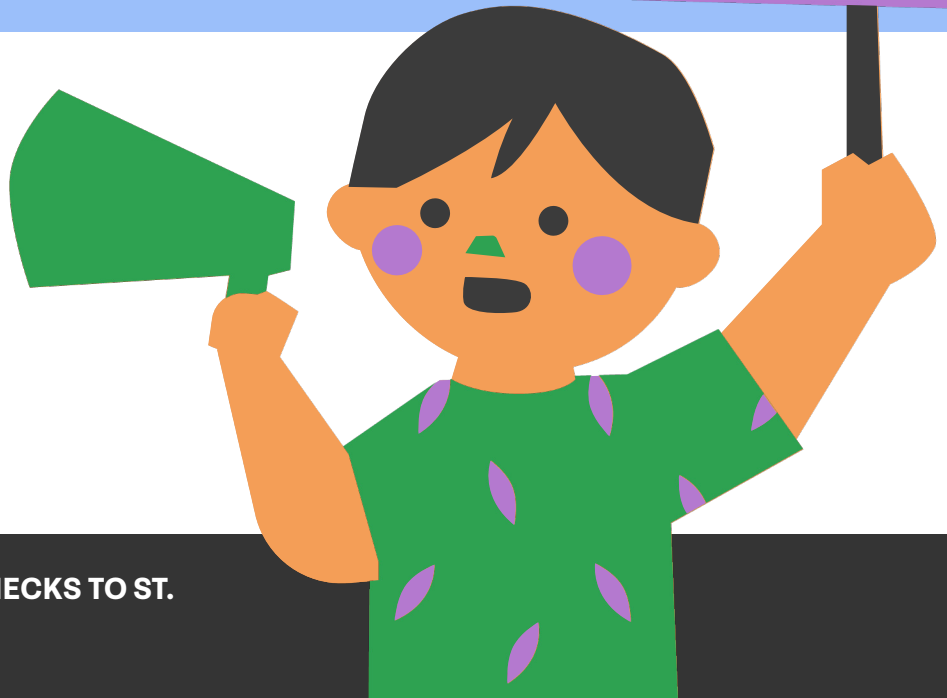
Please Support our Annual Walk-a-thon Fundraiser

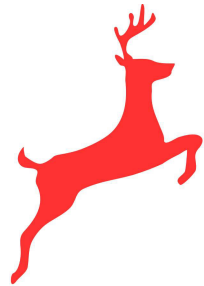
