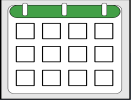
Faith Friday Update

Missing Alexis Foundation

Alexis MacKenzie Loudon was stillborn at full term on July 7, 2004. Having seen an incredible lack of pregnancy and infant loss grief resources in the Northern Kentucky community, the Missing Alexis Foundation was established in 2008 to begin meeting this need. Since that time, the Missing Alexis Foundation has been formed to encourage, promote, and provide support, compassion and healing to families who have experienced the loss of a child through miscarriage, prematurity, stillbirth, S.I.D.S. and all other forms of fetal and infant death in the greater Cincinnati area. They have helped countless families with medical and funeral costs, including Mrs. Witte and her family. The Missing Alexis Foundation is deeply committed to supporting and serving families who are grieving, and in need of support, right here in our community. Please, let us offer our Faith Friday to Gregory David Witte, and all children who were lost too soon.

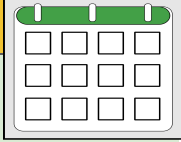
Viernes de Fe

Fundación Missing Alexis

Alexis MacKenzie Loudon nació muerta a término el 7 de julio de 2004. Tras observar una increíble falta de recursos para el duelo por la pérdida de un bebé y un embarazo en la comunidad del norte de Kentucky, en 2008 se creó la Fundación Missing Alexis para empezar a cubrir esta necesidad. Desde entonces, la Fundación Missing Alexis se ha formado para alentar, promover y proporcionar apoyo, compasión y curación a las familias que han experimentado la pérdida de un hijo por aborto involuntario, prematuridad, muerte fetal, S.I.D.S. y todas las demás formas de muerte fetal e infantil en el área metropolitana de Cincinnati. Han ayudado a innumerables familias con los gastos médicos y funerarios, incluida la Sra. Witte y su familia. La Fundación Missing Alexis está profundamente comprometida a apoyar y servir a las familias que están de duelo, y en necesidad de apoyo, aquí mismo, en nuestra comunidad. 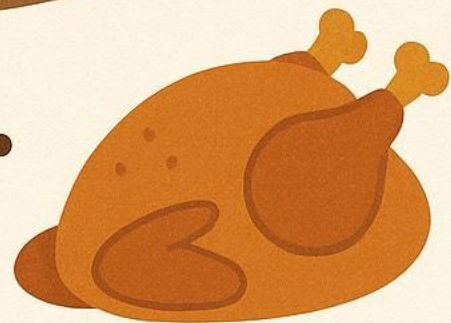

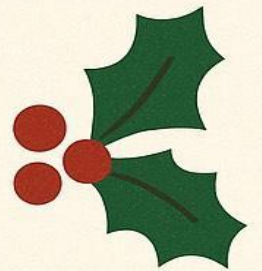
