Next Friday, February 6 will be a Faith Friday. Proceeds from that Friday will go to Pregnancy Center West. Thank you for your support.



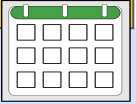

SUBJECT: School Health Policy

Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s),

As we continue the school year through these colder months, I wanted to reach out and remind everyone of the school health policies that we have in place in order to keep everyone safe and healthy throughout the remainder of the school year. Please see the following below for health concerns your child/children may have throughout the rest of the year that would require them to stay home from school and what has to happen in order for them to be able to return.

- Fever: Has to be fever free for 24 hours **WITHOUT** the use of fever reducing medications and has to be able to participate in normal daily activities.
- Vomiting: Has to be 24 hours from last time vomited and is able to handle a normal diet.
- Diarrhea: Has to be 24 hours since the last time they had diarrhea and is able to handle a normal diet.
- Strep: Has to be on an effective antibiotic for 24 hours and symptoms have to be improving.
- COVID-19: Has to be fever free for 24 hours **WITHOUT** the use of fever reducing medication, has to have improving symptoms, and has to be able to participate in normal daily activities.
- Flu: Has to be fever free for 24 hours **WITHOUT** the use of fever reducing medication, has to have improving symptoms, has to be able to handle a normal diet and has to be able to participate in normal daily activities.

If everyone follows these policies, we can all work together to keep everyone safe and healthy during this school year. Estimados padres/tutores:

A medida que el año escolar continúa durante estos meses más fríos, quería recordarles las políticas de salud escolar que hemos implementado para garantizar la seguridad y la salud de todos durante el resto del año escolar. A continuación, les presentamos las inquietudes de salud que sus hijos podrían tener durante el resto del año y que los obligarían a quedarse en casa y qué debe suceder para que puedan regresar.

- Fiebre: Debe estar libre de fiebre durante 24 horas **SIN** el uso de medicamentos para reducir la fiebre y debe poder participar en las actividades diarias normales.
- Vómitos: Deben haber transcurrido 24 horas desde el último vómito y ser capaz de llevar una dieta normal.
- Diarrea: Deben haber pasado 24 horas desde la última vez que tuvo diarrea y ser capaz de manejar una dieta normal.
- Estreptococo: debe estar tomando un antibiótico eficaz durante 24 horas y los síntomas deben estar mejorando.
- COVID-19: Debe estar libre de fiebre durante 24 horas **SIN** el uso de antipiréticos medicamento, tiene que tener síntomas que mejoren y tiene que ser capaz de participar en actividades diarias normales.
- Gripe: Debe estar libre de fiebre durante 24 horas **SIN** el uso de medicamentos para reducir la fiebre, tiene que tener síntomas que mejoren, tiene que ser capaz de llevar una dieta normal y tiene que ser capaz de participar en las actividades diarias normales.

Si todos seguimos estas políticas, podemos colaborar para garantizar la seguridad y la salud de todos durante este año escolar. 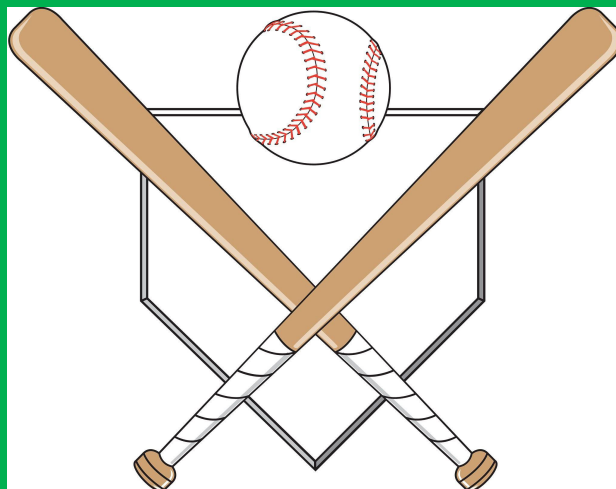
