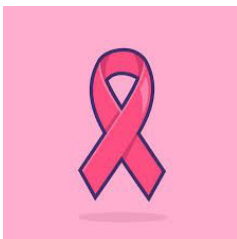


Faith Friday

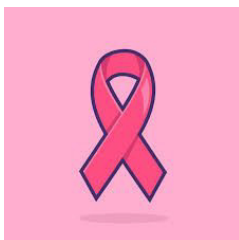

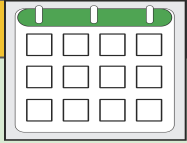

Dear St. Teresa of Avila School Families,

We hope this letter finds you and your family well. We are deeply grateful for the trust you place in St. Teresa of Avila School and for the privilege of walking alongside you in your child's academic, spiritual, and personal growth.

For the upcoming **2025-2026 school year**, the tuition rate will be **\$6,350 per student**. As in previous years, this amount does not reflect the full cost of educating each child. After careful review, the actual cost of education is approximately **\$7,000 per student**. Thanks to careful management of operating expenses and the continued generosity of our parishioners, we are able to keep tuition increases as modest as possible despite rising costs. Through the continued generosity of St. Teresa of Avila Parish, a **subsidy** is provided for each student to help bridge this difference, resulting in **no additional cost to families**.

Registration & Fee Updates

Please note the following changes for the upcoming school year:

- **Registration Fee:** Increased from **\$50 to \$100** per student.
- **Student Fee:** The **Technology Fees** will remain the same; however, they will **be due in the summer**, along with class fees. This will now be referred to as the **Student Fee**.

Priority registration will begin on **January 5th**. Families who register during the priority registration period will receive **50% off the registration fee**, owing **only \$50 per student in January**.

Priority registration is essential for our current students, as it allows us to accurately plan class sizes, schedules, and teacher assignments for the upcoming school year. It also ensures that our current students secure their spot before enrollment opens to new students. Open House for new families will be held on January 29, 2026, from 6:30-8:00 PM.

Please be sure to **complete priority registration by January 30th** to guarantee your spot and take advantage of this savings opportunity.

We ask families to consider volunteering their time and talents in support of programs that help sustain the parish subsidy and offset rising costs. These efforts allow us to continue providing a high-quality Catholic education while keeping tuition increases modest. Opportunities include:

- Tuesday Night Bingo (volunteering and participation both provide financial support to the school)
- Recess Volunteer*
- Lunchroom Volunteer*
- Field Day / Field Trip Volunteer*
- Parent Teacher Group (PTG)
- Participation in and support of fundraisers throughout the year

***SafeParish training is required to volunteer with children.**

We hope that St. Teresa of Avila School will continue to be a place of comfort and sanctuary for your children and your family. Thank you for your continued commitment to Catholic education, and specifically to St. Teresa of Avila School.

St. Teresa's mission is to empower students to develop strong academic skills in a Catholic environment by educating the whole child — spiritually, intellectually, physically, socially, and emotionally. Our goal is to enable our students to flourish to their full potential, knowing that God truly loves them.

Estimadas familias del Colegio Santa Teresa de Ávila:

Esperamos que esta carta les llegue bien a usted y a su familia. Les agradecemos profundamente la confianza que depositan en el Colegio Santa Teresa de Ávila y el privilegio de acompañarlos en el crecimiento académico, espiritual y personal de su hijo/a.

Para el próximo **Año escolar 2025-2026**, la tasa de matrícula será **\$6,350 por estudiante**. Como en años anteriores, esta cantidad no refleja el costo total de la educación de cada niño. Tras un análisis minucioso, el costo real de la educación es de aproximadamente... **\$7,000 por estudiante**. Gracias a una gestión cuidadosa de los gastos operativos y a la constante generosidad de nuestros feligreses, podemos mantener los aumentos de matrícula lo más moderados posible a pesar del aumento de los costos. Gracias a la continua generosidad de la Parroquia Santa Teresa de Ávila, una **subvención** se proporciona a cada estudiante para ayudar a superar esta diferencia, lo que da como resultado **Sin coste adicional para las familias**.

Actualizaciones de registro y tarifas

Tenga en cuenta los siguientes cambios para el próximo año escolar:

- **Cuota de inscripción:** Aumento de **\$50 a \$100** por estudiante.
- **Tarifa de estudiante:** El **Tarifas de tecnología** seguirá siendo el mismo; sin embargo, lo hará **debe nacer en el verano**, junto con las cuotas de las clases. Esto ahora se denominará **Tarifa de estudiante**.

La inscripción prioritaria comenzará el **5 de enero**. Las familias que se registren durante el período de inscripción prioritaria recibirán **50% de descuento en la tarifa de inscripción**, debido **sólo \$50 por estudiante en enero**.

La inscripción prioritaria es esencial para nuestros estudiantes actuales, ya que nos permite planificar con precisión el tamaño de las clases, los horarios y la asignación de profesores para el próximo año escolar. También garantiza que nuestros estudiantes actuales aseguren su lugar antes de que se abra la matrícula para nuevos estudiantes. La jornada de puertas abiertas para nuevas familias se llevará a cabo el 29 de enero de 2026, de 18:30 a 20:00 horas.

Por favor asegúrese de **completar el registro prioritario por 30 de enero** para garantizar tu lugar y aprovechar esta oportunidad de ahorro.

Pedimos a las familias que consideren ofrecer voluntariamente su tiempo y talentos. En apoyo a programas que ayudan a mantener el subsidio parroquial y a compensar el aumento de costos. Estos esfuerzos nos permiten seguir brindando una educación católica de alta calidad, manteniendo al mismo tiempo los aumentos de matrícula moderados. Las oportunidades incluyen:

- Bingo de los martes por la noche (tanto el voluntariado como la participación brindan apoyo financiero a la escuela)
- Voluntario de recreo*
- Voluntario del comedor*
- Voluntario para día de campo/excursión*

- Grupo de padres y maestros (PTG)
- Participación y apoyo a eventos de recaudación de fondos durante todo el año.
